AIEEE Exam Papers have the choice of appearing for any one of the two types of papers or both. Paper I is for those who wish to opt only for BE / BTech courses in colleges accepting AIEEE ranks while Paper II is for those who wish to pursue a course in BArch / BPlanning.

Paper I: This is a three – hour paper comprising three sections: Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. There are 30 questions in each of the three subjects. The questions are of objective type ie multiple – choice questions with a single correct answer.

Paper II: This three – hour paper consists of Mathematics, Aptitude and Drawing. The Mathematics section has 35 – 40 objective type multiple – choice questions with a single correct option and 1 / 4th negative marking. In this part, the syllabus for Mathematics comprises common topics from Class XI / XII, CBSE / State board.

DCE CEE Entrance exam has 60 objective type questions from Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics each. There are four options for each question with one correct answer. A right answer gets the candidate 4 marks and 1 mark is deducted for an incorrect answer.

SRM Engineering Entrance Exam (SRMEEE) is conducted each year by SRM University for admission to its B.Tech courses. This exam includes various multiple type questions from physics, chemistry, maths and biology. The applicants need to prepare hard to get their desired courses.

The paper will be of 2 and a half hours duration having objective questions from the following subjects:

Physics-35 questions for a total of 105 marks, Chemistry-35 questions for a total of 105 marks, Mathematics-35 questions for a total of 105 marks, Biology-50 questions for a total of 105 marks. All candidates have to attempt Physics and Chemistry sections. Candidates have to attempt Mathematics for all courses except the bio-engineering courses for which they have to attempt biology section. Each of the questions will have four options. There will be negative marking for an incorrect answer of 1/3rd of the total marks allotted to each question.
