Who are eligible for Medical casual vacancy round?

Ans: All Medical/ Dental rank holders are eligible to participate in Medical / Dental casual vacancy round. Candidates who have selected any seat or not selected any seat or attended or not attended the admission round are eligible in the casual vacancy round of Medical / Dental as per their merit and schedule.

Which application form should I use - Online or Application form purchased from Post Office?

General candidates who wish to avail reservation :- benefits	Use application form purchased from Post Office only.
SC/ST candidates :-	Use application form meant for SC/ST purchased from Post Office only.
ST candidates with annual family income less than Rs.40,000/-	:- Can use application form obtained free of cost from ST Development Department
General candidates who do not wish to avail any reservation benefits	:- Can apply online or use application form purchased from Post Office.

What is the Cost of Application form?

ST candidates (including ST inter-caste) whose annual family income is below Rs.40,000/- can have application form free of cost from the ST Development Department Rs.350/- for SC/ST





candidates (including SC/ST inter-caste) Rs.700/- for all others. Rs.8500/- extra for those opting DUBAI as centre of exam.

How to obtain EAMCET 2010 Application forms?

Application forms with the enclosures including the "Instruction Booklet" can be had in person (not by post) on payment of Rs 250/-, which includes cost of application, fees for entrance test, and service charges, at all e-seva centers within the state of Andhra Pradesh and designated main branches of Andhra bank outlets.
