Fees hike expected for professional courses

Be it in engineering, pharmacy, MBA or MCA, the fee is expected to get dearer by 20 to 30 per cent. What's more, the college authorities are claiming that implementation of sixth pay commission is the sole reason leading to increase in the fee.

There are some 300 self-financed institutes in Gujarat offering professional courses in engineering, pharmacy, MBA, MCA, and diploma engineering. These colleges have more than 60,000 seats. Federation of Self-Financed Technical Institutes of Gujarat has demanded that engineering college fees should be hiked to a minimum of Rs 75,000; pharmacy to Rs 1 lakh, and MBA and MCA to Rs 1.25 lakh per annum.

The old colleges will also see a minimum hike of 20 per cent in their fee. Till date, for degree pharmacy courses the average fee ranges between Rs 42,000 to Rs 65,000. For engineering courses average fee ranges between Rs 36,000 to Rs 55,000 while MBA fee is Rs 36,000 to Rs 57,000. New, hiked fees will be announced just before admission begins in July. Committee will hold a number of meetings before that. All colleges have been asked to submit their annual audit reports.

Fresh dates for admission into engg courses

Ahmadabad: The admission committee for professional courses (ACPC) on Thursday issued new dates for the admission into engineering degree and diploma courses. The fresh dates have been issued keeping in view the opening of new colleges and addition of seats after approval by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).

The final list of institutes and the number of seats to be filled will be declared on July 5. The students will have to fill the choices of their subjects for the actual admission round - I that will be on from July 5 till July 9. The display of filled and locked choices will have to be done by candidates on July 10 and July 11. During the same time, the candidates whose forms have discrepancies will have to report to ACPC for corrections.

Declaration of the first allotment list will be done on July 14. The students will have to deposit the tuition fee and submit their original documents between July 17 and July 18. The academic session will begin on July 19. The students whose name appear in the merit list but fail to take admission, ACPC will contact them on July 19 and July 20 and the final report of vacant seats in engineering degree and diploma seats will be submitted on July 20.

As the new IIM does not have a building of its own yet, it would, for the time being, function from the Maharshi Dayanand University (MDU) campus. MDU would also be providing temporary residence to the faculty members from IIM-Lucknow. The IIM is currently providing 50 seats, all of which have been filled up for the current academic year.

India-US higher education summit from July 30

Mumbai: Mumbai will host a three-day India-US Summit on higher education to mark the golden jubilee of the Indo-American Society, an official said on Thursday. The event will be inaugurated by Union Human Resource Development Minister Kapil Sibal on July 30. The event is expected to create collaborations between educational institutions, and exchange programmes involving students, faculty and researchers from both India and the US.

Tech varsity rules don't permit hike as yet

The fee regulatory committee, technical, headed by retired high court judge Akshay Mehta has sought clarity from the state government in connection with a directive that specifies that all fee hikes shall be in place for a period of at least three years. The reason for this is that the rules governing Gujarat Technological University say that the fee structure shall be revised after every three years. And, the last revision was in 2008, so according to the norm, the fee revision should happen in 2011, and not now.

Merit list for medical and paramedical courses declared

Ahmadabad: The Admission Committee for Medical and Paramedical Courses declared merit list of 11,257 students on Friday. Of these students, 10,590 are from the state education board and 578 from the CBSE. The merit has given a breather for those seeking admission into highly competitive medical courses in the state. The list this time has gone down by two marks as compared to last year. Overall, the merit is expected to be down by up to 8 marks.

of Admission Committee for Professional Courses (ACPC) said the first student who got admission into medicine last year had scored 98.60 per cent marks while this year, it had gone down to 98.38 per cent marks. Between rank 1 and 100, the marks have gone down from 94.4 per cent to 92.8 per cent. The lowering of the merit is attributed to better average performance in Gujarat Common Entrance Test (GujCET), the marks for which are included in HSC score to form the final merit list.

Last year, there were 1,490 sanctioned seats on which admission was given and merit had closed on 81. This year, there are an estimated 1,905 medical seats. Some of these are yet to get final nod from Medical Council of India, which is expected to come soon. "If state gets the expected seats, it will be good news for students as final merit is expected to go down by as much as 8 to 10 marks," an official said.

Increase in PG engg, pharma seats

Ahmadabad: The All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has approved 684 seats for the Master of Engineering and Master of Technology courses and another 960 seats for Master of Pharmacy. This increase in the post-graduation seats would help the state to get more qualified candidate as teaching faculty in the engineering and pharmacy colleges. The recent increase would take the number of post-graduation seats to 1,584 in the Master of Engineering (ME) and Master of Technology (MTech) and 1,560 seats in Master of Pharmacy (MPharma).

3 English-medium BCom colleges get 650 seats

Gujarat University has decided to add 650 seats in English medium of the first year of three commerce colleges after more than 1,700 students applied for admission into FY BCom. "More than 80 per cent had applied in English medium so GU decided to increase the number of seats in three commerce colleges," said GU vice chancellor Parimal Trivedi. The seats have been increased in two divisions of each college. These include KK Shastri College in Maninagar, two divisions each in morning and evening sessions of Gujarat College. The university will shortly scrutinize the applications and prepare merit list accordingly.

Jamia begins sports category admissions

The Jamia Millia Islamia University Monday began trial of aspiring candidates who have opted for admissions in various courses under the sports category. New rules for MBA, BE courses

Government has announced new admission and fee fixation rules for MBA, BE and BTech, BPharm and other professional courses under the Gujarat Professional Technical Education Colleges or Institutions Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fess Act 2007. Under new rules for MBA, 50% marks (45% marks in case of SC and ST candidates) shall be computed on the basis of grand total or cumulative grade point average as shown in the final year mark sheet of the university.

Under new rules for BE, the tuition fee waiver scheme shall be applicable to all sanctioned seats of engineering and pharmacy courses in government colleges/institutions and aided colleges/institutions and all sanctioned seats in unaided colleges/institutions which have opted for granting admission under the TFW scheme and have obtained approval of AICTE.

GTU students get new Email IDs

Gujarat Technological University (GTU) will now provide personal e-mail ids to students of colleges affiliated to it. This is likely to benefit some four lakh students. 16 colleges qualify for GU affiliation

Only 16 of 92 new institutes seeking affiliation with Gujarat University qualify to launch their courses as per the new rules issued by University Grant Commission (UGC).
